When you visit our website, it will send a cookie to your device. This is a small piece of information stored on your hard drive that tells us that your computer has accessed our website.

We use cookies to collect data from our website to help us understand which of our website pages are most popular and when the peak usage times are, along with other information about Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, referring website addresses, application activity logs and error logs that helps us improve the content and make the navigation of our website easier.

We use analytics tools to analyse our web traffic to help us to improve the website structure, design, content and functions.

Are our cookies safe?

Cookies do not provide us with access to your computer or any information about you, other than that which you choose to share with us.

If you do not want to use cookies you can set your browser to reject them. However, this may affect how our website functions on your computer. Some pages and services may become unavailable to you.
